Located in one of Contra Costa's detention facilities, the Engraving and Sign-Making Program was designed to provide female inmates with a vocational training program. Inmates enrolled in this program are given specialized training in a variety of skills including engraving, banner production, and sign fabrication, as well as vehicle decaling and detailing. The instructors also focus on developing work ethics and personal responsibility, as well as self-esteem and confidence building. The goal of the program is to couple vocational training with soft skills, to build a solid foundation to assist inmates with obtaining employment upon release.
